Manylion Karl Jenkins oddi ar y we:

Karl Jenkins is the UK's most popular contemporary composer, and one of Wales' most versatile and critically-acclaimed musicians.

He was born in 1944 and was raised in Penclawdd, South West Wales. His father was a school teacher, organist and choir master, who taught Karl music theory and the piano.

While at Gowerton Grammar School, Karl played oboe in the National Youth Orchestra of Wales, before reading music at the University of Wales, Cardiff. He went on to study at the Royal Academy of Music in London.

Jenkins initially focused on playing jazz, with performances at Ronnie Scott's legendary club.

He started a media company, writing jingles and music for adverts. Credits included BA, Renault, Volvo, De Beers, Tag Heuer and Pepsi. His company also re-recorded I Heard It Through The Grapevine for Levi's famous advert starring Nick Kamen:

He is perhaps best-known today for the Adiemus project. The 1994 album Adiemus: Songs Of Sanctuary, described by Jenkins as "an extended choral-type work based on the European classical tradition, but where the vocal sound is more akin to 'ethnic' or 'world' music."

Karl Jenkins has also composed for the Royal Ballet, the National Youth Orchestra of Wales, Lesley Garrett and Bryn Terfel among others. He has also scored and conducted an album of rock classics by Bonnie Tyler, and produced music by Catrin Finch for Sony Classical.

In recent years Jenkins has been given a host of accolades, including being made a fellow and associate of the Royal Academy of Music, and a fellow of the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama.
